1 INTRODUCTION

The 2021 Sea Scout Rowing Regatta will be held on Seapoint Beach in Dún Laoghaire. Registration will open at 0830hrs on the Green beside the beach, with the event commencing with a casual Fall-in at 0900hrs. This will be followed by a Coxswain's Briefing, with the first race commencing shortly after the Briefing. Participating troops are requested to have their skiffs ready to go on Seapoint Beach in time for the Fall-in to allow races to begin straight away. Unfortunately, as a result of the Covid pandemic, only Skiff races will be run this year. There will also be no BBQ this year and access to the Scout den will only be allowed for using the toilets.

2 RULES

1. Scouting Spirit must be adhered to.
2. Collisions must be avoided at all costs.
3. Boats must first round the turning mark of the lane they are allocated, leaving the mark to starboard. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
4. Boats approaching the turning marks must give way to any boat coming off the turning marks.
5. If a team cannot be located for a race, or is late to the start line, it will forfeit that race.
6. In the case of a Protest, the Race Committee on the shore must be notified immediately after the race in question.
7. The Officer of the Day will have the final word on all matters.
8. Each Troop present will be responsible for their own members safety in relation to Covid and will be responsible for the sanitisation of their own equipment or any equipment they use.

An [online registration form](#) must be submitted before **Sunday 29 August** to confirm the number of teams entering. A separate entry form (attached below) must then be submitted on the day of the Regatta. Lane draws for the above races will be made at the Rowing Regatta Meeting on **Monday 30 August** at 2000hrs in 1st Port Ringsend. All races are subject to cancellation due to weather or lack of entries.

All entrants must be members of Scouting Ireland, and must have a valid Activities Consent Form. All rowers must be at the correct age for their race on **1 June 2021**. In the case of a pair oar and cox race, the coxswain must also be at the correct age.

4 ADDITIONAL NOTICES

- The normal Scouting Ireland Boating Guidelines will apply. The requirement to wear a 100N lifejacket may be relaxed to wearing a 50N buoyancy aid.
- The Regatta will be held on Seapoint Beach this year, please see below map. A swimmer-exclusion zone will be in place on the course for the duration of the event.
- All participants are expected to be respectful of other beach-users on the day, and to follow the instructions of the Race Marshalls.
- All participants are asked to use the footpaths when walking from the 8^ú Calafort Scout Den to Seapoint Beach.
- Boats can be launched from Seapoint Beach before Fall-in.
- Please be advised that there has been anti-social behaviour in the past at the back of the car park to the rear of the 8^ú Calafort Scout Den. 8^ú Calafort members have been subjected to intimidation, theft, dangerous driving and vandalism in the past. Any Regatta participants travelling by car are therefore advised not to park in this car park on the day, and all participants are advised not to leave any valuables lying around.
