



To mark 110 years of Sea Scouting we are offering every Sea Beaver, Sea Cub, Sea Scout, Sea Venture, Sea Rover & Sea Scouter the chance to earn a Commemorative badge by participating in a Commemoration of Sea Scouting in their locality.

Activity Summary

This is a National Commemoration being organised as a locally run activity. It involves Sea Scout Groups engaging in a celebration of Sea Scouting in their own unique ways. In order to be eligible to wear the badge each Youth Member & Scouter must undertake the following challenges.

Programme Sections from 'Different Scout Groups' in partnership undertake a Nautical activity applicable to that Programme Section and the skill level of the young person (it must be a joint activity, with a non - Sea Scouting Group)

It must be borne in mind that each Beaver/Cub/Scout/Venture/Rover/Scouter will do their best and that the participation may be at different levels dependent on their experience.

All participants will earn this Commemorative Badge.

Sea Scout Groups should include badges for their link group when placing an order.

Rationale

This Commemoration is about:

- Engaging in a fun outdoor water activity
- Getting back to a full Sea Scouting programme post-covid
- Learning a new skill or improving on a current skill
- Bringing to benefit of Sea Scouting to non-Sea Scout Groups

Environmental Impact & Leave no Trace

While the activity itself should not generate waste, it is still important that any waste is disposed of correctly from the area where the activity is to take place.

Please remember the principles of Leave No Trace on the day of the event.
